All children are expected to wear full school uniform.

Winter Uniform

Navy Blue School **Logo** Sweatshirt or **Logo** cardigan

Sky blue polo shirts (preferably with the **Logo**)

Boys – Grey trousers; black or grey socks

Girls – Grey trousers, grey skirt/tunic/dress; grey or black tights/ white socks

Shoes - black (flat)

Summer Uniform

Boys – Grey shorts and as above

Girls – Blue gingham dress or grey shorts and as above

Shoes or closed toe sandals - black (flat)

P.E. and Games kit

Shorts (navy) or skort (navy) (shorts should be a sensible length)

White School **Logo** T-shirts

Navy Blue School **Logo** Hoodie (no fashion hoodies) or school **Logo** Sweatshirt

Trainers (preferably black or white)

Navy tracksuit bottoms or leggings (no large fashion logos or colours)

From September, all children will require a named pair of wellies to use at school throughout the year.

Long hair should be tied back with plain school colour hair ties.

From September, historic uniform, with the large printed logo, should NOT be worn. Children can continue to wear the small stitched logo uniform.
