Don't forget the cyber awareness and online safety workshop for parents is booked for 6pm on 11th November. Please sign up on ParentPay to register your attendance.



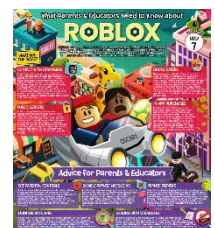
