Every Day Counts....

Is your child Pupil Premium?

Are you a low-income family who currently receive Income support, Jobseeker's allowance, Employment and Income Support or Child Tax Credit. If so, you may qualify as Pupil Premium.

What does this mean?

The school can receive additional funds to support your child practically, academically, socially and emotionally. Your child would continue to receive free school meals, even in Key Stage Two, and we pay for one club, choir milk, fruit snack, uniform (logo) and trips.
