## Staffing

This year, the class will be taught by Mrs Ramage. The class will be supported by Mrs Parson who will work every morning and some afternoons. One P.E. lesson will be taught by Astrella and French will be taught by Mrs Crosse.

## Curriculum

This year, we have so much exciting curriculum to cover! Each term, you will be sent home a 'learning web' which gives key information about what we will be learning in each subject area. You will find the autumn term learning web enclosed with this letter. We will be working hard towards the SATS in May. Further information will be given out closer to the time regarding arrangements.

## Home Learning

Children will have one piece of Maths homework and one piece of English homework each week. Children will be told what they need to complete and there will also be a reminder on SeeSaw. Homework will be set on a Friday and due the following Friday. Children are expected to read and practise their times tables (or other Maths skills) at least four times a week at home. Children can record this in their reading record. Children are asked to bring in a reading book of their choice from home each term, children will also be asked to complete at least one piece of topic learning at home. ## P.E. Days

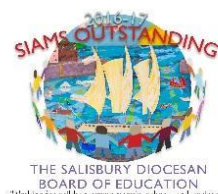
This term, P.E. days will be Tuesdays and Wednesdays. Children can attend school dressed in their P.E. kits on these days. Full school uniform is required other days.
