DSAT Parent Survey Results

18th July 2025

Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you to those parents who completed the recent DSAT parent survey. We are aware that with the recent OFSTED and SIAMs inspections you have been asked to complete multiple surveys so we are grateful for your time and your thoughtful feedback.

Although the number of responses was relatively small, we'd like to share an overview of the results:

Positive responses

77%

In general, how satisfied are you with the school's efforts to engage you as a parent?

What we're proud of

We are pleased to see so many positive responses that reflect the strong relationships and trust within our school community:

- **97%** of parents feel confident that their child's teachers are able to keep them safe.
- **90%** feel respected by the school.
- **94%** feel well-informed about their child's attendance.
- **87%** would recommend the school to others.
- **88%** find parents' evenings useful, and **85%** understand the school reports. In response to last year's feedback, we introduced Autumn, Spring, and Summer reports, along with two face-to-face parents' evenings, to keep you fully informed about your child's progress.
- **88%** find it very easy to contact the school.

Looking to Improve

We also appreciate the constructive feedback shared, which helps us identify areas for development:

- **69%** of parents are satisfied with our communication methods. We recognise that using multiple platforms can be confusing, and we're reviewing ways to streamline communication. Most parents indicated a preference for email or face-to-face conversations.
- **44%** feel that their feedback has an impact on the school.
- **67%** feel optimistic about their child's progress.
- **43%** understand the role of the Trust within the school, and only **17%** feel confident that being part of a Trust benefits pupils. Over the coming months, we'll be sharing more about the Trust's involvement and support through our newsletter and website.
