Here is an outline of everything you need to know for the build-up and planning of our first ever car boot sale!...

Pitch Bookings for Sellers Cars

- These MUST be pre-booked, and are for Cars Only (No Vans): booking fee £10 per car
- Bookings to be opened on Classlist next week

Bottle Tombola & Drink Raffle

- **Friday 23rd May: Non-Uniform Day in exchange for a bottle of drink**
- There will be 2 sections to this tombola – 1 side for alcoholic bottles, and 1 side of non-alcoholic beverages. Then a separate drink raffle.
- A non-uniform day on the last day of term will please be in exchange for *any* bottle to contribute to this... This will operate the same as any other non-uniform 'exchange day' (i.e. Christmas hampers, chocolate bingo) with boxes on classroom doors to take donations on entry.
- *Please can parents ensure any alcohol donations are handed in themselves and not, for example, sent in with children on buses!*

Plant Sale

- Are there are any green-fingered family members out there, that we could make a plea to for any surplus plants for our plant stall at all??!
