FOBS Support to School

Around Easter time, we were requested to support the purchase of 3 new outdoor storage cupboards. These units have now arrived and in situ! They are split across KS1 and KS2 playgrounds, benefitting all the children across the school, and safely house a variety of play equipment which the children have direct access to in order to enhance their playtimes and lunchtimes.



Next week is STEM Week across the school, which FOBS is funding. There are a variety of fun STEM based activities planned from both staff and outside providers, and we hope the children have a really fun and inspirational week ahead!
