A SEND lead worker, from Wiltshire, will be attending and will explain the different processes and procedures in place within the local authority, including EHCPs (Educational Health Care Plans) applications. Mrs Moriarty will be talking through our school approach and how we support pupils with additional needs at Broad Chalke.
