Please ensure work is beautifully presented.

Ideas for this term's home learning could include (please choose from below or think of your own idea):

- Create some natural art inspired by Andy Goldsworthy. Make patterns and designs out of natural resources and then take a photograph.
- Create a piece of art focused on a natural landscape inspired by the work of Georgia O'Keeffe.
- Experiment with mixing tints and tones to create a range of colours and produce artwork based on your favourite place in the world.
- Research William Morris and create a piece of artwork inspired by repeating patterns in the natural world.
- Learn a new crafting skill such as cross-stitch, knitting, crochet or embroidery and take a photograph of what you produce.
- Listen to and review some music that is from another country from around the world. What do you like about it?
- Practise your photography skills and produce a portfolio of photographs inspired by the world around you.
- Write a biography for an artist that inspires you. This could be a painter, sculptor or musical artist.
- Use chalk to create a piece of artwork outdoors and take a photograph of it to share.
- Create a butterfly garden, bird feeder, insect home or bird house to encourage nature to flourish in your local area.
- What are you thankful for? Create a piece of narrative, poetry, artwork or music that expresses this.
