- Find out about a biome (such as rainforest, polar or desert) and create a piece of art about it. Perhaps you could make a collage or some digital art!
- Create a poster advertising a holiday destination.
- Learn some words in another language.
- Think of a way to care for wildlife in our local environment: perhaps you could create an insect house or a bird feeder and take a picture.
- Research someone who has done something amazing in our world and collect some information about them.
- Write a poem or a prayer for our world.
- Design a board game based on countries of the world.
- Watch (an age appropriate!) David Attenborough documentary and record your favourite facts.
- Go outdoors and record the sounds, scenery and wildlife you see.
- Create a kindness calendar and record ways in which you've shown respect to others.
